- Tinned Meat
- Rice Pudding/Sponge Pudding
- Custard
- Jam or Spread
- Biscuits and Snacks

If you are able to donate, please send your donations in with your child on Wednesday 3rd July 2024 and they can place them inside of the crates located in their classrooms for the foodbank.
