Area of Learning	Activities	Area of Learning	Activities
Communication and Language	This half term we will focus on our new theme 'Where my feet take me'. We will hear and learn new vocabulary from stories, rhymes and poetry based around the topic. We will take part in group/whole class discussions based around journeys and things our feet can do! We will explore the themed enhancements within provision giving us the opportunity to use the new language we have learnt! We will also prepare for our transition into Reception by taking part in group discussions.	Mathematics	During Summer 2 we will continue to develop our problem-solving skills. We will continue to use symbols and begin to make marks with mathematical meaning. We will verbally count beyond IO daily and practice our number recognition. We will continue to compare objects and quantities along with exploring addition and subtraction practically!
Physical Development	This half term we will continue to develop our confidence and skills within the outdoor provision; using the climbing frame, exploring bikes and scooters and playing throwing and catching games. We will take part in obstacle courses giving us the opportunity to build on our balancing skills and travel in different ways. We continue to develop our fine motor skills by taking part in various different creative activities, mark making and writing opportunities.	Understanding the World	This half term we will continue to learn about the seasons and seasonal changes. We will go on a Summer's walk around the school grounds to discuss changes in the environment. We will complete observational drawings of plants and flowers.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	During Summer 2 we will look back on our experiences throughout the year and talk about the things we have enjoyed the most. We will continue with our RSE curriculum to learn more about ourselves and others. We will prepare for our transition to Reception by meeting our teacher and visiting the class.
